Camp Verde/South Verde High School

The Kiwanis Club of Camp Verde is pleased to announce the thirty-second annual scholarship program for graduating seniors in the Camp Verde Unified School District. One graduating student will be chosen for the award. That student will be eligible for a renewal of the award in each of the next three years, provided the student remains a full time student in good standing at a post-secondary educational institution.

The scholarship will be awarded to the student that most completely meets the qualifications as described. The award will be in the form of a check written to the admitting school "*FBO the award winner*". The award may be used for tuition, fees, books, materials, on-campus housing or any other related educational expenses.

Any questions concerning this Scholarship program may be directed to the High School guidance counselor.

The deadline for the return of the completed application to the Camp Verde/South Verde High School guidance counselor's office is 3:30 P.M., Monday, April 13, 2015.

To be eligible for this Scholarship, the student must:

- Be a graduating senior of Camp Verde or South Verde High School with a commitment to continuing education in a post-secondary institution.
- Enroll in the immediately ensuing term at the admitting school.

Guidelines to consider when applying are as follows:

- Kiwanis is a community service organization that promotes youth leadership.
- There are no restrictions on course of study, type of institution, or its location.
- The money award is to be used for educational expenses as defined above.
- The student must enroll in, and continue their studies with a full time class load as defined by the institution they attend.
- The selection committee may request an interview of applicants for the award.
- Extenuating circumstances which may relate to any of the above can be considered at the discretion of the Scholarship Selection Committee.
