Two letters of recommendation from people not related to you who know you.

One letter of recommendation from a teacher

An essay from you, telling about yourself, why you want to continue your education, your career goals and how receiving this scholarship will impact your future ambitions. The essay should be not more than 250 words. (Be sure to include your financial need information)

The award for Mingus is the Jerry Bachle Master Mechanic Award. The amount of this scholarship is \$3000. **Only apply for this scholarship if you are going to a vocational program i. e.: Cosmetology, mechanic of any type, plumber, electrician etc.**

**Eligibilities:** Graduating high school senior that is in the top **10-25** percent of the graduating class. This is a needs based scholarship.

Complete the **vocational** application (can **not** apply for the academic scholarship)

An official transcript (the guidance office will attach to your completed packet)

A letter of recommendation from your principal or counselor

Two letters of recommendation from people not related to you who know you.

One letter of recommendation from a teacher

An essay from you, telling about yourself, why you want to continue your education, your career goals and how receiving this scholarship will impact your future ambitions. The essay should be not more than 250 words. (Be sure to include your financial need information)
