<u>Motion:</u> Mrs. McDowell moved, seconded by Mrs. Schneider to accept Dr. Lee's letter of resignation effective June 30, 2015. The motion passed 4-0.

6. <u>DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON THE DEVELOPMENT OF A</u> <u>GOVERNANCE TEAM HANDBOOK, BOARD GOALS AND STRATEGIC</u> PLAN

The Board worked through the creation of a Governance Team Handbook using a model from Payson Unified School District. The Items addressed in the Handbook included: Operating Principles; Roles and Responsibilities of the Governing Board and Superintendent;

Agreements/Protocols; New Board Member Orientation; Board Meeting Preparation: Agenda Questions Prior to a Meeting; Board Agenda Items;

Board Meeting Conduct; Purpose of Consent Agenda; Superintendent - Board Communications; Strategic Planning: District Strategic Plan; Strategic Planning: Board-Superintendent Goals; Board Evaluation; Superintendent Evaluation; District Spokesman; Board Member's Role in Public; Confidentiality; Handling Concerns/Complaints from the Public and Staff; Requests for Information; Site Visitation; Board Member Participation in Meetings at School Sites; Board's Role with Attorneys; Board's Role with Consultants; and Policy and Regulation Development.

Mrs. Schneider exited the meeting at 8:24 am and returned at 8: 29. Mrs. McDowell exited the meeting at 11:00 am and returned at 11:03. The Board took a recess at 11:25 am and reconvened at 11:35 am. Hiring a company or consultant could cost the District about \$5,000.00. The Board will consider how they would like to move forward on a superintendent search during their meeting on February 10, 2015. No action was taken on the item.
